More than 1,800 visitors came to the History Center to view exhibits, attend programs and do research.

Open Hours:

For half of the year the History Center was open Tu-Fri 10-4pm and Sat-Sun 1-4pm.

In September we changed our open hours to Tu-Sat 10-4pm due to a lack of visitors on Sundays.

Overall, a team of 12 volunteers assisted with Visitor Services in 2019. A docent training program is planned for 2020.

Genealogy Series

Our popular series of genealogy programming continued with Kenyatta Berry, co-host of *The Genealogy Roadshow* and author of *The Family Tree Toolkit* offering her tips on how to navigate your genealogy journey.

Gail Lukasik, author of *White Like Her*, returned to talk about her own genealogy journey of self-discovery.

And, Dr. Daniel Hubbard gave a crash course on understanding the use of DNA in solving family history mysteries.

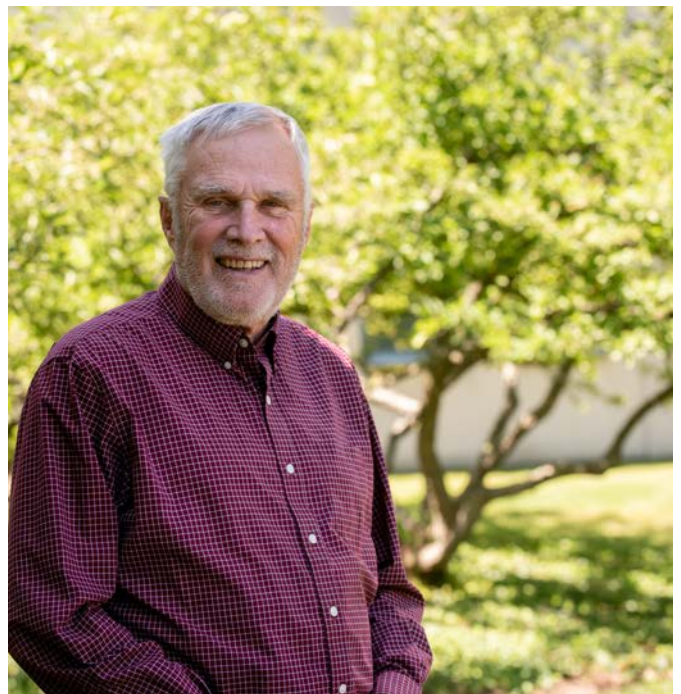

The History Center's new location provided the opportunity to host larger crowds which came in handy for our numerous sold-out events!

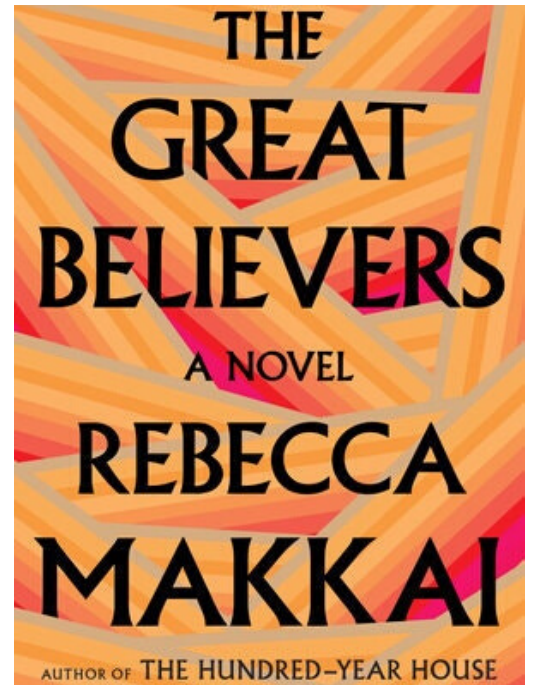
Local Legends

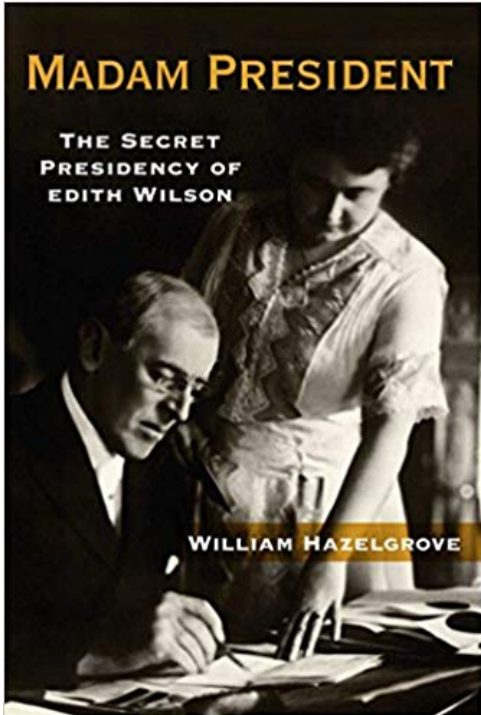
PROGRAMS



A panel discussion on the public management of epidemics was especially ground-breaking, as participants from Abbott, AbbVie, Northwestern Lake Forest Hospital, and the AIDS Foundation of Chicago presented a multi-faceted look at epidemics, with an emphasis on the management of the 1980s AIDS crisis.

A temporary display of a section of the AIDS Quilt made a dramatic statement as the backdrop for this important discussion.

A Man of His Time, A Man for all Times

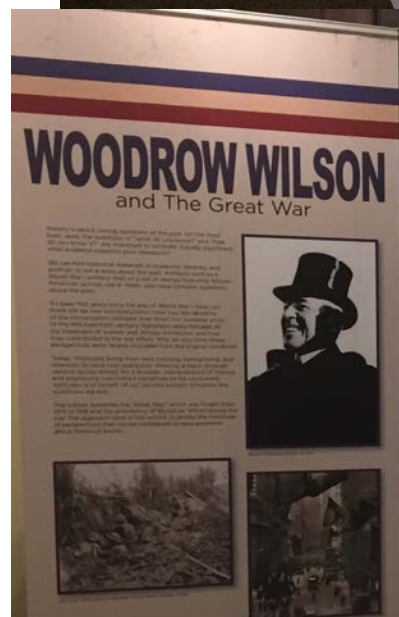

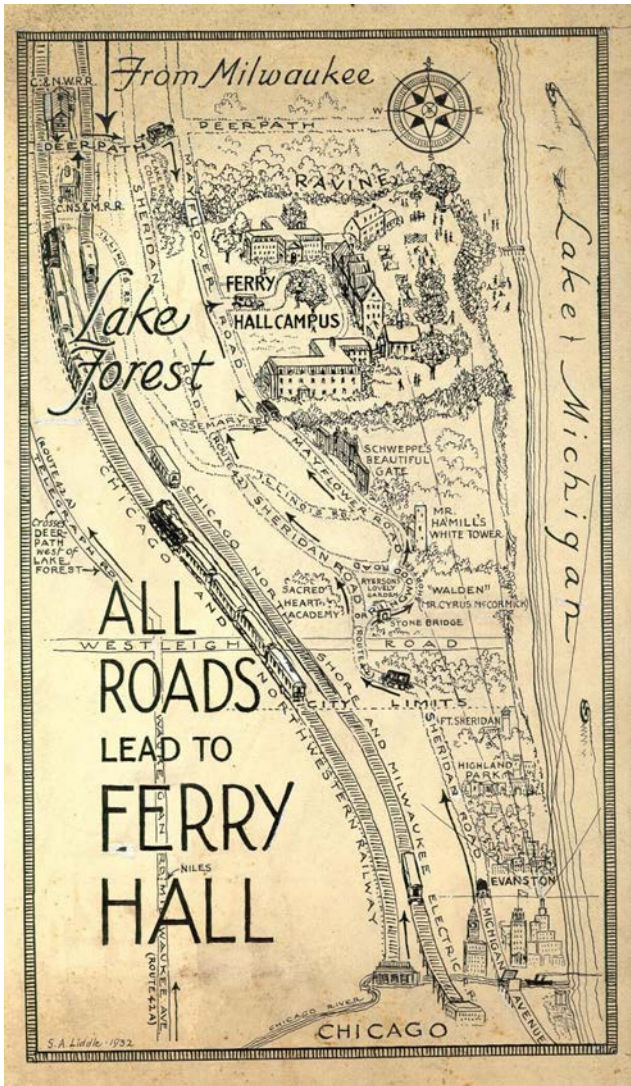

Newly accessioned



In December the History Center received an outstanding new archival collection documenting the work of mid-century architect Jerome Robert Cerny. The collection, which encompasses hundreds of drawings, detail sketches, photographs, and color renderings, was donated by architect Jon Welker, a successor of Cerny's at Jerome Cerny Architects. Cerny designed many notable residences, both in Lake Forest and around the country. He lived in Lake Forest and had his office in Market Square.
